

Bull Shoals Lake Tailwater White River — Mirror Lake

A fishing license (Page 5) and a trout permit are required to retain trout from any state waters. Licenses or permits are not required for children under 16.

Regulations

WHITE RIVER (on facing page)

In the following areas, trout must be released immediately. Only artificial lures with a single, barbless hooking point may be used (natural or scented baits are not allowed). Chumming is not allowed.

- Monkey Island Catch-and-Release Area: From the upstream end of Monkey Island to the mouth of Moccasin Creek, as indicated by signs.
- Sylamore Catch-and-Release Area: Between the upstream and downstream boundary signs as posted by the Arkansas Game and Fish Commission near the Mt. Olive Access and near Jack's Resort.

MIRROR LAKE (Blanchard Springs – Stone County)

Open to fishing with rod or pole only. Anglers may use no more than two fishing rods and must attend them at all times. No other devices may be used to catch fish. Handicapped-accessible fishing pier available.

Norfolk Lake Tailwater North Fork River (on Page 20)

A fishing license (Page 5) and a trout permit are required to retain trout from any state waters or to fish in the North Fork River below the dam. Licenses or permits are not required for children under 16.

Regulations

There is a daily limit of five trout. Only one Brown trout, 24 inches or longer may be taken. Only two Brook trout, 14 inches or longer may be taken. Only two Cutthroat trout, 16 inches or longer may be taken.

NORTH FORK RIVER (map on facing page)

- Norfolk Tailwater: From 100 yards below Norfolk Dam to White River. Anglers may use no more than one fishing rod or pole and must attend it at all times. No other devices may be used to catch fish. Chains or other objects capable of destroying aquatic vegetation may not be dragged. No fishing, boating or wading within 100 yards below Norfolk Dam.
- Norfolk Catch-and-Release Area: From Otter Creek to 100 yards above Bill Ackerman/River Ridge Walk-in Access, as indicated by signs. Trout must be released immediately. Only artificial lures with a single, barbless hooking point may be used (natural or scented baits are not allowed). Chumming is not allowed.
- Bill Ackerman/River Ridge Walk-in Access: Handicapped-accessible fishing pier available.

DRY RUN CREEK (Outflow from Norfolk National Fish Hatchery)

Only youths under 16 and mobility impaired anglers may fish Dry Run Creek (Norfolk National Fish Hatchery outflow) from sunrise to sunset. Fishing from piers is limited to mobility impaired anglers only. Catch-and-release area. A mobility impaired card is required for mobility impaired adult anglers. Trout must be released immediately. Only artificial lures with a single, barbless hooking point may be used (natural or scented baits are not allowed). Chumming is not allowed. Anglers may use no more than one fishing rod or pole, and must attend it at all times. No other devices may be used to catch fish.
